- 1. Your subscription including the affiliation fee will be collected by your society in the usual way.

If you are a higher rate taxpayer, you can also claim back the difference between the standard and higher rates of tax in your self-assessment tax return.

The claim can be back dated to cover donations from 6 April 2020.

If you wish for your previous donations via the affiliation fee to be included, please ensure that you leave that option on the form open.
