

THE ARTS SOCIETY RUTLAND TREASURER'S REPORT 2023

The Arts Society Rutland made a loss of £2,890 in the year to 31st July 2023. A loss of £2,975 was reported for the previous year ending 31st July 2022.

Income (£8,511)

Subscriptions and guest fees £7,846

- Net membership numbers were down by 26; from 170 to 144. Although 18 new members joined, 44 members left. This net reduction in members reduced our expected income by £1,430.
- Other Income e.g. bank interest etc. of £665 was higher than in 2022 when a loss of £264 was made.

The committee will continue to endeavour that visits, study days etc. do not make a loss.

Expenditure (£11,401)

- Nine lectures were held at the Raven Hotel. Total costs including the fees for the lecturers, hire of the room and technical support amounted to £7,298; an average of £811 per lecture. The lectures were of exceptional quality and the committee believe that bringing a high standard is important for the members.
- Being part of The Arts Society means that each year we are charged an affiliation fee, for 2023 this was £2,710.
- Other expenditure of £1,393 was slightly lower than in 2022 (£1,530).

Wherever possible costs are kept to a minimum however, as with everything else in these times our costs for lecturers etc. continue to rise.

With Members' Funds in hand of £10,150, the Society has sufficient cash to continue to function at current levels of income and expenditure for a few more years. However, for our longer term survival we need to generate more income.

Please do invite friends to try a lecture and to join us, we need more members.

Subscriptions for 2024 will be £63 per head.

We believe that this still offers amazing value for 9 professional lectures.
